A Licence has been granted for this competition and accreditation will be applied for through SASA North District. Each competitor should bring (as a minimum): *Sufficient water in a plastic water bottle(s); *Shorts & t-shirt to wear over the swimsuit/swim shorts at all times when not swimming; *Poolside shoes (e.g. crocs/clean trainers/flip flops); *Hand sanitiser. Poolside/changing room access will be limited to team coaches and chaperones up to a maximum of one coach/chaperone per 10 swimmers, with a maximum of 3 coaches/chaperones at any one time. Belongings should be placed in the lockers provided. Seating areas will be allocated to each team. Teams are responsible for ensuring that their swimmers recognize the importance of "giving people space", especially when moving through the seating and marshalling areas. Participating clubs will receive one copy of start sheets for each session. Coaches should ensure that their swimmers enter and exit the warm ups at the allotted times. Swimmers must not enter the pool until their warm-up start is announced and must follow all instructions. Full warm up details will be issued prior to the meet. Over the top starts will be issued at the discretion of the Meet Referee. The meet organisers and the facility management cannot be held responsible for items lost or damaged during the course of the event.
